Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that 5.06 crore Building and Other Construction (BOC) workers are registered with Building and Other Construction Workers' Welfare Board (BOCWVB) across the country;**
- (b) whether it is also a fact that BOCWVB collected ₹ 87,478 crore cess for the welfare of BOC workers till November, 2022, if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether it is also a fact that BOCWVB spent ₹ 49,269 crore only and remaining ₹ 38,209 crore were unspent till November, 2022; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for the unspent amount?**
