- (a) & (b): Vacancies arise in the Administrative Tribunals due to retirement, completion of tenure etc. Filling up existing and anticipated vacancies of Members of Central Administrative Tribunals (CAT) for the years 2022 and 2023 is under progress and the Government is taking expeditious action to complete the selection process at the earliest possible.
- (c) & (d): There is no proposal for setting up of more benches of CAT at present.
