EXTENSION OF PM KISAN BENEFITS TO LANDLESS FARMERS

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has received any representation from farmers engaged in farmingactivities but not having agriculture land in their name, for getting the benefits of PradhanMantriKisanSammanNidhi (PM KISAN) Yojana;
- (b) if so, details of thereof;
- (c) whether Government has taken any action in this regard;
- (d) if so, details thereof; and
- (e) if not, reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) to (e): The Pradhan MantriKisanSammanNidhi (PM-KISAN) Scheme is a Central Sector Scheme. PM-KISAN provides an income support of Rs. 6000 per year in 3 equal instalments to all farmer families with cultivable landholding irrespective of the size of the landholding, subject to certain exclusion criteria. Requests to include landless farmers under the PM-KISAN Scheme have been received from time to time. However, ownership of cultivable landholding remains the basic criteria to avail benefits under the Scheme.
