SOIL HEALTH CARD

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- a) whether events regarding farmer training, exhibitions, farmer fairs and workshops have been organized State-wise under Soil Health Card Management during the last year;
- b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- c) the number of laboratories functioning for making Soil Health Cards, State-wise; and
- d) the details regarding the Soil Health Card laboratories and the efforts for public awareness about Soil Health Card among farmers and measures taken after obtaining the results of Soil Health Card?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) to (d): Soil Health Card/ Soil Health Management Schemes under National Project on Management of Soil Health & Fertility is implemented through the State Government since 2014-15. Under the scheme assistance is provided to states in promoting Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) through judicious use of chemical fertilizers including secondary and micro nutrients in conjunction with organic manures & bio-fertilizers for improving soil health and its productivity. The components like, setting up/ strengthening of Soil Testing, Fertilizers/ Bio-fertilizers & Organic fertilizers Quality Control Labs, promoting Micro-nutrients, testing soil samples to issue Soil Health Cards and trainings/ demonstrations/ krishi mela/ workshops etc. are

implemented in the scheme. Soil Samples are processed as per standard procedure and analysed for various parameters viz, pH, electrical conductivity (EC), Organic Carbon, available N, P, K, S and micronutrients (Zn, Cu, Fe, Mn & B). Soil Health Card provides information to farmers on soil nutrient status of their soil and recommendation on appropriate dosage of nutrients to be applied for improving soil health and its fertility. Under the scheme, since 2015, around 6.45 lakh demonstrations, 93781 farmers' trainings and 7425 farmers melas are organized.

However, during the last year 2021-22, the release of funds is dependent upon various enabling conditions like utilization of funds released earlier, submission of Utilization certificate, receipt of physical-financial progress, receipt of matching State share compliance by States / Union Territories of relevant Government of India guidelines etc. Non fulfillment of enabling conditions adversely affects the release funds to States/ Union Territories and the release of funds to States was slow during 2021-22. As a result, last year, no fund was released farmer training, exhibitions, farmer fairs and workshops to be organized by the States/ Union Territories under the scheme. The State-wise details of soil testing laboratories is at Annexure-I.
