NATIONAL PROGRAMME ON ORGANIC PRODUCTION

1976 SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE & INDUSTRY** be pleased to state:

- (a) details of funds allocated and utilized under the National Programme on Organic Production (NPOP) in last five years, year-wise, State-wise and district-wise for Punjab;
- (b) details and amount of organic agricultural products exported to other countries in last five years under the programme, year-wise, State-wise;
- (c) amount of revenue generated by exporting organic agricultural products in last five years, year-wise, product-wise; and
- (d) details of the steps taken by Government to increase the quality of organic agricultural products in the country in last five years, year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) National Programme on Organic Production (NPOP) is an accreditation and certification programme for organic production, which is financially self-sufficient. Government does not allocate any funds for implementation of NPOP.
- (b) & (c) The details and amount of organic agricultural products exported to other countries in last five years under NPOP, year-wise, state-wise details are at **Annex-I** andthe details of revenue generated by exporting organic agricultural products during the last five years, year-wise and product-wise are at **Annex-II**.
- (d). The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), a statutory body under the Department of Commerce, has the responsibility to implement NPOP. In order to improve the quality of organic agriculture products, APEDA organises capacity building and training programmes, webinars, etc for various stakeholders viz. Certification Bodies, State Government officials, organic farmers, etc to familiarize them with the requirements of organic production, inspection and certification procedures, requirements of organic exports, etc.
