- (a) whether private companies are being involved in the production of nuclear energy;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the startups are being promoted in nuclear energy and allied sectors; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a)&(b) The Indian private sector is contributing in a big way to the country's Nuclear Power Programme by providing core reactor components, equipment, materials and services in areas that include construction, fabrication & erection of equipment, piping, electrical, instrumentation, consultancy, auxiliary and logistical services.
- (c)&(d) Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) procures a large number of goods and services through Government-e-Marketplace (GeM) and from MSMEs. These MSMEs include several startups. NPCIL continuously strives to develop more vendors, particularly those from SC/STs and Women, including startups.
