CONVERSION OF ICF RAKES INTO LHB RAKES IN SOUTHERN RAILWAY

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the expected date for conversion of all Integral Coach Factory (ICF) rakes of Southern Railway into Link Hofmann Busch (LHB) rakes and the details thereof; and

(b) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) and (b) To ensure improved safety and better travelling experience, Indian Railways, from the year 2018 onwards, have discontinued the production of ICF coaches and only Link Hofmann Busch (LHB) coaches are being manufactured. Conversion of trains operating with ICF coaches into LHB coaches is being done in a phased manner, subject to operational feasibility, availability of rolling stock etc. Presently, there are 201 rakes of Southern Railway that are being utilized for operation of Mail/Express trains out of which 100 rakes are LHB.
