(a)& (b) Yes, Sir. Ministry of Railways have been allocated Rs. 2,40,000 crore as Gross Budget Support (GBS) for Capital Expenditure during 2023-24. It comprises of Rs. 1,85,000 crore under Capital, Rs. 45,000 crore under Railway Safety Fund and Rs. 10,000 crore under Rashtriya Rail SanrakshaKosh.

(c)Funds from the enhanced budgetary allocation have been allottedfor works under PlanheadsNew Lines, Doubling, Traffic Facilities, Rolling Stock, Electrification Projects, Customer Amenities and Investment in PSU/JV/SPVs. The zone wise fund allocation under GBS for 2023-24 in Budget Estimatesis shown in the following table-
