PROPOSALS FROM TAMIL NADU TO CONSTRUCT ROB AND RUB

2055. SHRI K.R.N. RAJESHKUMAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) details of the proposals received by the Ministry from the State of Tamil Nadu to construct Railway Over Bridges (ROB) and Railway Under Bridges (RUB) under “Deposit Work” model;
- (b) status of works completed and the details of the pending works lying with the Ministry at various stages; and
- (c) by when the pending “Deposit Work” will be completed?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Total 32 works (27 for Road Over Bridges (ROBs) and 05 for Road Under Bridges (RUBs)) have been approved under deposit work. Out of these 1 ROB and 3 RUBs have been completed. Remaining ROB/RUBs are in various stages like planning, estimation and execution & are being taken up by State Govt. through its agencies.

The approaches for all above ROB/RUB work are being executed by State Govt. Authorities. Completion of any ROB/RUB work depends on various factors like cooperation of State Governments in consent for closure of LC, fixing of approach alignment, approval of General Arrangement Drawing (GAD), quick land acquisition, removal of encroachment, shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, law and order situation in the area of project / work sites, number of working months in a year for particular project / work

sites due to climatic conditions etc. All these factors affect the completion time of the projects / works. Therefore, it is not feasible to fix definite timelines for completion of these ROB/RUBs.
