Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of the progress of the centrally sponsored scheme for enabling the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) to set- up Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETP) in the country;
- (b) the total number of CETPs set up in the country so far, State-wise;
- (c) the total amount disbursed by the Ministry and the total amount utilized by the MSEs till now; and
- (d) the other initiatives taken/being taken by the Government to strengthen the functioning of MSEs across the country?

(a) to (c): Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) does not implement any scheme for enabling the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) to set- up Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs) in the country.

(d): This Ministry implements various schemes and programmes for promotion of MSME Sector in the country. These schemes and programmes inter-alia include MSME Champions Scheme, Prime Minister's Employment Generation programme (PMEGP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises, Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Procurement & Marketing Support Scheme etc.
