UJJWALA SCHEME IN THE STATE OF WEST BENGAL

2217 DR. SANTANU SEN:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of gas connections allotted under the Ujjwala scheme since the inception of the scheme, year-wise, State-wise and district-wise for the State of West Bengal;

(b) the number of gas connection holders who did not refill gas cylinder more than three times since the inception of the scheme, year-wise, State-wise and district-wise for West Bengal; and

(c) the details of the amount of subsidy given to BPL families by Government since the inception of the scheme, year-wise, State-wise and district-wise for West Bengal?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (c)

Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) was launched on 01.05.2016 to release deposit free LPG connection in the name of adult woman member of poor households across the country. The target to release 8 crore connections was achieved in September, 2019. To cover the remaining poor households, PMUY phase-2 (Ujjwala 2.0) was launched in August 2021 with a target to release 1 crore additional PMUY connections, which was achieved in January 2022. Subsequently, the Government decided to release 60 lakh more LPG connections under Ujjwala 2.0 and as on 01.01.2023, the target of 1.60 crore Ujjwala 2.0 connections has already been achieved.

LPG connection under PMUY is released in the name of adult women of the poor households, provided no LPG connection exists in the name of any family member of the household and fulfilling other terms and conditions. Households belonging to Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) list or from seven other categories such as Scheduled Caste(SC) Households, Scheduled Tribe(ST) Households, Most Backward Classes (MBC), Beneficiaries of PM Awas Yojana (Gramin), Beneficiaries of Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY), Forest Dwellers, Resident of islands/ river islands, Tea garden / ex-tea garden workers or poor households not covered under the above categories by submitting 14 point declaration are eligible for a PMUY connection. Under Ujjwala 2.0, a special provision has been made for migrant families who can use a self-declaration instead of Proof of Address and Ration Card to apply for a PMUY connection.

During Financial Year 2020-21, the Government had provided upto 3 (three) free of cost LPG refills to PMUY beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP). Under this Scheme, 14.17 crore free refills were provided to the PMUY beneficiaries. The Government has started a targeted subsidy of Rs. 200 per 14.2 Kg cylinder for PMUY beneficiaries for upto 12 refills for year 2022-23. The details of subsidy on domestic LPG given by Government during each of the last five years are given below:

To insulate domestic LPG consumers from fluctuations in international prices, Government modulates the effective price to consumer for domestic LPG. The subsidy, as admissible, is credited to the bank account of eligible beneficiaries. Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies(OMCs) have suffered huge losses on sale of domestic LPG. To compensate these losses, Government has provided a one-time compensation of Rs. 22000 crore to OMCs in FY 2022-23.

Under PMUY, Government bears an expenditure of upto Rs 1600 per connection for Security Deposit (SD) of Cylinder, Pressure Regulator, Suraksha Hose, DGCC booklet and installation charges. State/UT-wise and year-wise details of LPG connections released under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) are at **Annexure-I**. District-wise and year-wise details of LPG connections released under PMUY in the State of West Bengal are at **Annexure-II**.

State/UT-wise and year-wise details of PMUY beneficiaries who have taken not more than three are at **Annexure-III**. District wise details of PMUY consumers who have taken not more than 3 refills since inception is not maintained.
