# KEY PROJECTS DELAY DUE TO LAND ACQUISITION, CLEARANCE AND APPROVALS

#### 2234. SHRI JAGGESH:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government has red-flagged a decline in private investments in the country's infrastructure sector due to delays in land acquisition and clearance approvals for key projects;
- (b) if so, number of key projects delayed due to land acquisition, clearance and approvals in the country, State-wise; and
- (c) steps taken by the Government to make State Governments to implement land reforms and model policy frameworks to address the challenge, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION, MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS [RAO INDERJIT SINGH]

(a) & (b) The Infrastructure and Project Monitoring Division (IPMD) of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation is mandated to monitor time and cost overruns of Central Sector Infrastructure Projects costing Rs. 150 crores and above, based on the information provided by the project implementing agencies on Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) of this Ministry. As per the mandate, the number of projects added and investment made during the last 2 years and current year (upto January, 2023) and the number of key projects delayed due to land acquisition, clearance and approval in the country, State-wise is at Annexure-A and Annexure-B respectively.

(c) The steps being taken by the Government to control the delays are: Periodic review of projects under PRAGATI; rigorous project appraisal; On-line Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) for better monitoring; setting up of Revised Cost Committees in the Ministries; regular review of infrastructure projects by the concerned administrative Ministries; and setting up of Central Sector Projects Coordination Committees (CSPCCs) in the States under the concerned Chief Secretaries for removal of bottlenecks and for facilitating the speedy implementation of major projects
