GROSS STATE DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GSDP) OF STATES

2238. SMT. PHULO DEVI NETAM:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to State:

(a) the current Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) of States, the details thereof including average annual growth rate during last five years;

(b) the contribution of agriculture, animal husbandry, and cooperative sector in GSDP of States, the details thereof; and

(c) whether the Government proposes to formulate any plan or to provide any assistance or consultation in order give push to the States having low GSDP, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION, MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS (RAO INDERJIT SINGH)

(a): As per information provided by Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES) of respective State Governments, the State-wise Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) and percentage growth of GSDP for the period of 2017-18 to 2022-23 at Current as well as Constant (2011-12) Prices is given in Annexure-I.

(b): As per information provided by DES of respective State Governments, the State-wise contribution of crop and live stock sector in GSDP of States during the period from 2017-18 to 2022-23 at Current Prices are given in Annexure-II. As far as contribution of cooperative sector in GSDP of States is concerned, Government does not compile Gross State Value Added (GSVA) separately for this sector and therefore it is not available.

(c): Government has taken various initiatives to promote growth at the national level as well as all-inclusive growth in states. Some of the steps include:

- NITI Aayog and Asian Development Bank have undertaken project, Strengthening the States/UTs for broad based urban development with the aim to sensitise state governments on the importance of developing appropriate policy frameworks at the state and city level; identifying key bottlenecks that constrain Indian cities from fully realizing their potential as engines of growth, developing implementable solutions to

these bottlenecks, and informing policy makers about the types of investments and activities that states and cities should prioritize from a growth and jobs perspective.

- Social Progress Index (SPI) for States and Districts is tracked that can serve as a holistic measure of a country's social progress at the national and sub-national levels to assess states and districts across critical dimensions of social progress - Basic Human Needs, Foundations of Wellbeing, and Opportunity.
- 'Districts as Export Hubs Initiative' has been launched to identify and promote products and services with export potential for all districts of the country.
- Aspirational District Programme launched wherein 112 districts were identified across the country for special focus to bring about transformation.
- NITI Aayog has prepared key indices to rank performance across states across various parameters to identify key strength and weaknesses e.g. India Innovation Index, Multidimensional Poverty Index, State Energy and Climate Index etc.
- Development Support Services for States (DSSS) initiative by NITI Aayog with the vision to achieve transformational and sustained delivery of infrastructure projects and reboot infrastructure-project delivery models to establish a sustainable infrastructure creation cycle.
- NITI Forum for North-East set up in 2018 to address various challenges in the region and recommend requisite interventions to achieve sustainable economic growth.
- Project SATH-E, 'Sustainable Action for Transforming Human Capital-Education', was launched in 2017 to identify and build 'role model' States for the school education sector and improve performance of the education sector.
