Further, Government has implemented Nutrient Based Subsidy Policy w.e.f. 1.4.2010 for Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) Fertilizers. Under the policy, a fixed amount of subsidy, decided on annual/semi-annual basis, is provided on subsidised P&K fertilizers depending on their nutrient content. Also, under this policy, MRP is fixed by fertilizer companies as per market dynamics at reasonable level which is monitored by the Government. Thus, the NBS policy is market driven and the prices of P&K fertilizers i.e. the prices of DAP, superphosphate, NPK fertilizers are fixed by fertilizers companies. However, the subsidy given for these fertilizers under NBS policy during 2018-19 to 2022-23 is at Annexure A.

(b) & (c): Under the NBS scheme, the subsidy is given to registered P&K fertilizers manufacturers/importers which provide these fertilizers at subsidized price to farmers. The total amount allocated and the amounts actually disbursed with regard to fertilizer subsidies in the budget of the past five years are as under:

(d) & (e): Urea is provided to the farmers at a statutorily notified Maximum Retail Price (MRP). The MRP of 45 kg bag of urea is Rs.242 per bag (exclusive of charges towards neem coating and taxes as applicable). The difference between the delivered cost of urea at farm gate and net market realization by the urea units is given as subsidy to the urea manufacturer/importer by the Government of India. Accordingly, all farmers are being supplied urea at the subsidized rates.

As far as P&K fertilizers are concerned, in view of the increased international prices of finished fertilizers as well as its raw materials, Government of India under its Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) scheme has increased the subsidy for P&K fertilizers considerably over these years to absorb the pressure falling on farmers. The per kg subsidy rates for nutrients viz. N, P, K and S under NBS scheme is as under:

** A special one-time package with additional subsidy has been provided (effective from 01.10.2021 to 31.3.2022) for DAP at Rs.8769/MT and 3 most consumed NPK fertilizers (10:26:26, 20:20:0:13 and 12:32:16) at Rs. 2000/MT for each grade in order to make P&K fertilizers available at affordable prices to the farmers.

NOTE: An Additional Cost on production/ imports of DAP from 25.10.2021 to 31.3.2022 within a ceiling of Rs. 8000 at no profit/ no loss was also provided so that DAP (most consumed Phosphatic fertilizers by farmers) may be made available at affordable rates to farmers.
