NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION**

**2323. DR. K. LAXMAN:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to State:

- (a) whether it is a fact that funds released under National Health Mission by the Government were not properly utilized by Telangana Government;
- (b) if so, the reasons thereof;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the State Government has not been able to utilize super specialty hospitals constructed with a cost of ₹300 crores at Warangal and Adilabad with Central funds; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) to (d): Under the National Health Mission (NHM), financial and technical support is provided to the States/UTs for strengthening the healthcare systems, based on the proposals received from the States/UTs in their Annual Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) and subject to the Resource Envelope (RE).

Release and Expenditure under National Health Mission (NHM) to the State of Telangana from FY 2019-20 to 2021-22 is as follows:

The upgradation of Kakatiya Medical College, Warangal and Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Adilabad has been taken up under Phase-III of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) by the way of construction of Super Speciality Block (SSB), at approved cost of Rs.150 crore (Central share- Rs.120 crore and State share- Rs.30 crore) for each Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCI). These projects have been completed and have already been handed over to the State/GMCI authorities.

As per available information, both these Super Speciality Blocks are functional.
