(c) whether Government has undertaken a study on the long-term effects of covid vaccines and their relationship with heart disease?

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): According to the ICMR study Report "India: Health of the Nation's States", heart diseases contributed 28.1% of the total deaths in India, in 2016 compared to 15.2% in 1990. The detailed report is available at the following link-

Based on Adverse Event Following Immunisation surveillance there is no evidence of links between sudden cardiac deaths and Covid-19 vaccines.

Indian Council for Medical Research (ICMR) has not conducted any study in this regard.

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
