#### IMPROVING HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES IN THE COUNTRY

#### 2344. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to State:

- a) whether Government has received proposals from the State of Maharashtra regarding financial assistance for improving the health infrastructure in Government hospitals and if so, the steps taken in this regard;
- b) whether the Government is implementing any Centrally sponsored schemes for increasing health infrastructure in civil hospitals of States and if so, the total funds accrued to Maharashtra through these schemes in the last three years; and
- c) whether the neglect of investments in public healthcare infrastructure and the promotion of private hospitals to fill the gap have created a dependency on the private sector, if so, the details thereof and reaction thereto?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), under NHM provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs to strengthen their public healthcare system. Proposal from State/UT Governments are received in the form of Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs) and after appraisal approvals are given in the form of Record of Proceedings (RoPs) as per resource envelope of the State. The details of PIPs and RoPs for the past years are available at website of National Health Mission www.nhm.gov.in at the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) as under:

Ministry administers Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) which aims at correcting regional imbalances in the availability of affordable tertiary healthcare services and to augment facilities for quality medical education in the country. The Scheme has two components, namely, (i) Setting up of All India Institute of Medical Sciences(AIIMS); and (ii) Upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions(GMCIs). So far setting up of 22 new AIIMS and 75 projects of upgradation of GMCIs have been approved under the Scheme in various phases. The setting up of AIIMS contains Medical College, Nursing College, Hospital, Trauma Centre, Emergency, Blood Bank, ICU, Diagnostic & Pathology, Research etc. Upgradation of GMCIs under PMSSY broadly involves construction of Super Speciality Block (SSB) and/or Trauma Centre /or other facilities and/or procurement of medical equipment.

In Maharashtra, one AIIMS has been approved at Nagpur at an approved cost of Rs. 1577 crore under the PMSSY, which is functional. Further, the following Government Medical Colleges have also been taken up for upgradation in Maharashtra under PMSSY;

- **ii) Upgradation of existing State Government/Central Government medical colleges to increase MBBS seats in the country:** Under the Scheme, an amount of Rs. 171 crore has been released to the State Government till date for increasing 700 MBBS seats in 14 Medical Colleges. The details are at Annexure I:
- **iii)** Strengthening and upgradation of State Government Medical colleges for increasing PG seats: Under this scheme 11 medical colleges were approved for increasing a total of 692 seats. An amount of Rs. 233.39 crore has been released as Central Share. The details are at Annexure II

Under PM- Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM CSS component), so far in FY 2021-22 & 2022-23, support has been provided to the State of Maharashtra for establishment of 11 Integrated Public Health laboratories for an amount of Rs 13.75 crore and 11 Critical Care Hospital Blocks at District Hospital & Government Medical College level for an amount of Rs 293.85 crore
