TELEPATHOLOGY IN TREATMENT OF CRITICAL DISEASES

Will the Minister of **HEALTH and FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the state of telepathology in treatment of critical diseases;
- (b) the role it is playing in diagnosis and treatment of patients;
- (c) whether patients from rural areas particularly women are also getting benefits of telepathology in treatment of critical diseases;
- (d) if so, the number of beneficiaries in the last five years; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) Telepathology in India is still at a nascent stage. There is no documentary evidence of routine use of Telepathology for patient care. It can play a positive role in treatment of critical diseases.

Currently the diagnosis and treatment of patients through teleconsultation is provided through e-Sanjeevani telemedicine platform and the platform has rendered 10.49 crore consultations as on 16th march .
