(a) The main theme of New Delhi World Book Fair (NDWBF) 2023, held from 25th February to 05th March, 2023 was “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava”. The theme was showcased through a Theme Pavilion, spread across 1100 square metres, designed by National Institute of Design (NID), Ahmedabad.

(b) A total of 20 countries participated at the New Delhi World Book Fair 2023. There were 17 publishers from 14 countries, who put up their stalls. In addition, there were 29 foreign participants at the Publishing conference (at the New Delhi Rights Table session). A total of 12 countries participated at the International Events Corner in 33 sessions and panel discussions. The details are as under:
