- (a) whether the Ministry has any plans for operating a tribal university in North-Eastern States keeping in view of having huge population of tribal communities; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (b) Setting up of a Central University is a continuous process and is set up as and when need arises. A Regional Campus of Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantak has been established in Manipur in 2009. Further, there are number of Central Universities in the North-Eastern States at present viz. Nagaland University in Nagaland, Mizoram University in Mizoram, North Eastern Hill University in Shillong, Assam University & Tezpur University in Assam, Rajiv Gandhi University in Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim University in Sikkim and Tripura University in Tripura which caters the need of the North-Eastern States including its tribal population.
