Vacancies of teaching and non-teaching staff in Central Universities

2425: **Shri Neeraj Shekhar:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget allocated for financial year 2023-24 for filling up of vacancies of teaching and non-teaching staffs in Central Universities of the country, university-wise;
- (b) the details of percentage of posts of teaching and non-teaching staffs against total sanctioned posts, as on date, University-wise;
- (c) the details of vacancies of teaching and non-teaching staffs advertised and filled up during 2022-23 on permanent basis, university-wise; and
- (d) the number of vacancies for which recruitment process is still going on, University-wise?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION
(DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)**

(a): During the year 2023-24, a total amount of Rs.11613.97 crore has been proposed for allocation to Central Universities (CUs) under “Grants to central Universities”. Salaries of teaching and non-teaching staffs are met out of this provision only.

(b to d): Occurring of vacancies and filling thereof is a continuous process. The onus of filling up such posts lies on CUs which are autonomous bodies created under Act of Parliament. The details of percentage of teaching and non-teaching positions sanctioned posts (as on 01.02.2023) along with total teaching and non-teaching positions filled up in CUs from 05.09.2021 to 28.02.2023 and advertised as on 28.02.2023 are given at Annexure.
