Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vacant posts in various Central Universities in the country;
- (b) the details of vacant posts in Central Universities in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (c) the reasons for the delay in filling up the above posts, University-wise and the action taken by Government in this regard?

## **ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (c) Occurring of vacancies and filling thereof is a continuous process. The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength. The Ministry continuously monitors it with the Central Universities (CUs), however, the onus of filling up the posts lies on the Universities which are autonomous bodies created under Acts of Parliament. As on 01.02.2023, 6028 teaching posts and 16078 non-teaching posts are vacant in Central Universities under purview of Ministry of Education, including 325 teaching and 578 non-teaching vacancies in CUs in Madhya Pradesh. Ministry of Education has given directive to all the CUs to fill up the vacancies in a Mission Mode starting from 5th September, 2021. As per records available, recruitment for 1471 faculty and 654 non-faculty posts has been done in Central Universities from 05.09.2021 to 28.02.2023.
