Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) details of the storage capacity of Food Corporation of India (FCI) in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the storage capacity of FCI has been increased in Rajasthan by Government, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether FCI also stores foodgrains in warehouses, hired from private sectors, if so, the annual expenditure incurred thereon;
- (d) the State-wise/warehouse-wise details of foodgrains getting damaged in FCI and hired warehouses respectively during the last five years; and
- (e) whether Government has fixed any responsibility for the spoiled foodgrains, if so, the details thereof?

- (a): As on 01.01.2023, total covered storage capacity (Owned & Hired) available with Food Corporation of India (FCI) of central pool foodgrains stock is 348.13 Lakh MT. The Statewise details are enclosed at **Annexure-I**
- (b): FCI continuously assesses and monitors the storage capacity and based on the storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired through the following schemes: -
 - 1. Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme
 - 2. Central Sector Scheme (CSS)
 - 3. Construction of Silo's under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode
 - **4.** Hiring of godown from Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) /State Warehousing Corporations (SWCs)/State Agencies
 - 5. Hiring of godown through Private Warehousing Scheme (PWS)

As on 01.01.2023, 10.95 LMT covered storage capacity is available with FCI (owned+hired+state agencies) in Rajasthan, which is sufficient to meet 4 months' requirement of National Food Security Act (NFSA)/Other Welfare Schemes (OWSs), as per the norms.

(c): Yes, FCI also stores foodgrains in warehouses hired from private sectors. The Financial Year wise details of storage cost incurred by FCI in warehouses hired from Private Parties are as under:
