SHRI SYED NASIR HUSSAIN:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of routes identified for the Green Express Highway Project in the country;
- (b) whether the construction work has started on Green Express Highway in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government is using eco-friendly material for construction of Green Express Highways, if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether Government plans to set up only electric charging stations along the Green Express Highway and no petrol/diesel stations, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) The corridors proposed for construction of greenfield expressway/access controlled highway along with its status is attached at Annexure.
- (c) Yes Sir. The Government is using various eco-friendly material like fly/pond ash, plastic waste, waste material, geocell, geogrid etc.
- (d) The Government is constructing wayside amenities having provisions of electric vehicle charging stations, fuel stations (petroleum/diesel stations) on the expressways/access controlled highway.
