CONVERSION OF SHS INTO NHS UNDER NHDP

2482. SHRI PRAMOD TIWARI: DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA: SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA: SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria adopted for conversion/upgradation of various State Highways (SHs) into National Highways (NHs) in the country;
- (b) the details of SHs identified for upgradation into NHs in the country under the National Highways Development Project (NHDP) including States of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana and Tamil Nadu;
- (c) the number of SHs upgraded into NHs under NHDP so far in the country, State-wise and district-wise; and
- (d) the present status of such pending projects in the country, along with the time by which these pending projects are likely to be completed, project-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) State roads, including State Highways (SHs), are declared as new National Highways (NHs) from time to time on the basis of well-established principles. The criteria for State roads for declaration as new NHs may include some of the following:
 - i. Roads running through length / breadth of the country.
 - ii. Connecting adjacent countries, National Capitals with State Capitals / mutually the State Capitals, major ports, non-major ports, large industrial centers or tourist centers.
- iii. Roads having important strategic requirement in hilly and isolated area.

- iv. Arterial roads which enable sizeable reduction in travel distance and achieve substantial economic growth.
- v. Roads which help in opening up large tracts of backward area and hilly region.
- vi. Roads contributing towards achievement of National Highways grid of 100 km.
- vii. Synergy with PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP).
- (b) to (d) The Ministry keeps on receiving proposals from various State Governments / Union Territories (UTs), including from the State Governments of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana and Tamil Nadu, for declaration / upgradation of State roads, including SHs, as new NHs. The Ministry considers declaration of some State roads, including SHs, as NHs from time to time based on the requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of funds.

Development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. Works on notified NHs are taken up accordingly as per traffic density, condition of road, inter-se priority and availability of funds.

National Highways Development Project (NHDP) has been subsumed under Phase-I of Bharatmala Pariyojana (BMP). Phase-I of BMP is expected to be completed by 2027-28. State / UT – wise details of State roads, including SHs, notified as NHs in general including BMP since April, 2014 and also specifically under BMP, including for the States of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana and Tamil Nadu, are annexed.
