DEVELOPMENT OF MODEL VILLAGES THROUGH SAGY

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any scheme to develop Model Villages through Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY);
- (b) if so, details thereof; and
- (c) if not, reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) was launched in 2014 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister with the specific purpose of developing one village from each Parliamentary Constituency as a model village. So far, the Hon'ble Members of Parliament have identified 3156 Gram Panchayats for development under SAGY and there is continuous and progressive development of the identified GPs under SAGY. SAGY is focused on developing Model Gram Panchayats through implementation of Village Development Plans (VDPs) prepared under the guidance of Hon'ble Members of Parliament. The VDPs contain prioritized time-bound projects to be implemented through the convergence of resources from a range of existing Central Sector, Centrally Sponsored, State Schemes and from the Private, Voluntary and Cooperative sectors (PVC sectors). As per data updated by the respective State/UT Government on the scheme portal (<https://saanjhi.gov.in/>), 1,64,285 (70%) projects against the total 2,34,580 planned projects are completed as on today.
