EFFECTIVENESS OF MISSION ANTYODAYA

- (a) whether Government has evaluated the effectiveness of Mission Antyodaya;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the convergence of various schemes under Mission Antyodaya has been successful in optimum utilization of resources at the Gram Panchayat level;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether Government is planning to increase the coverage of Mission Antyodaya during the year 2023; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Mission Antyodaya (MA) Survey is a convergence and accountability framework which aims to bring optimum use and management of resources allocated by 27 Ministries/ Department of the Government of India under various programmes for development of rural areas. MA Survey provides secondary data to carry out gap analysis which is used as a key input for the preparation of Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) and other development plans at block and district level. The GP-wise ranking, which is the basic output of the survey, provides information on the relative success of convergent planning at the GP-level.

(e) & (f): The coverage of Mission Antyodaya Survey has increased from 2.53 lakh GPs in the 2019-20 to 2.68 lakh GPs in 2022-23.
