**SKILL TRAINING TO DOMESTIC WORKERS WORKING IN UNORGANIZED
SECTOR**

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government has initiated any scheme to provide skill training to domestic workers working in unorganized sector and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has also set up new Sector Skill Councils for domestic workers and if so, the details thereof and the objective behind the move; and
- (c) the target fixed by Government to provide skill development to those working as household workers during the next five years and the other steps being taken by Government in this regard?

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) through its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is delivering skills to youth of the country under domestic workers sector covering unorganized sector. Under PMKVY, as on 31.12.2022, 1.92 lakh candidates have been trained/oriented under domestic workers sector.

(b) MSDE through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) has facilitated the setting up of Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council (DWSSC) as an Industry-led autonomous body in 2015-16 to develop National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned job roles and course curriculum, conduct skill gap studies and assess and certify trainees of domestic workers sector.

(c) Short Term Skill Training is provided based on the market demand, therefore specific target has not been fixed for skill development of household workers.
