- (a) the welfare schemes run by the Central Government for the nomadic and semi-nomadic castes;
- (b) whether Gadia Lohar caste is included in the list of nomadic and semi-nomadic castes;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the people of the said caste comes under the Scheduled Tribes in all the States in the country and whether the facilities available to STs are given to these nomadic castes also, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The Ministry has launched the scheme "Scheme for Economic Empowerment of DNT Communities (SEED)" for welfare of DNT communities having following four components:-
 - (i) To provide coaching of good quality for DNT candidates to enable them to appear in competitive examinations,
 - (ii) To provide Health Insurance to them,
 - (iii) To facilitate livelihood initiative at community level; and
 - (iv) To provide financial assistance for construction of houses for members of these communities.
- (b) & (c) Gadia Lohar caste is included in the list of nomadic and semi-nomadic castes as per the draft report submitted by the National Commission for De-notified, Nomadic and Semi Nomadic Tribes. This report is available on the website of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.
- (d) No, Sir. Gadia Lohar community is not included in the Scheduled Tribe list of any of the States/UTs.
