Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- a. the details of the aims and objectives of the Swadhar Greh Scheme;
- b. the details of work done in the last three years with reference to the State of Rajasthan under the said scheme; and
- c. the year-wise details of the expenditure incurred in the last three years on the rehabilitation of women and achievement of objectives under the said scheme?

(a) to (c) Under the newly approved Mission Shakti, Swadhar Greh - for women in difficult circumstances and Ujjawala Home - for prevention of trafficking have been merged and renamed as Shakti Sadan which is an Integrated Relief and Rehabilitation Home for the women in distress situations and difficult circumstances. The residents of Shakti Sadan (Swadhar Greh) are provided shelter, food, clothing, health care and other daily requirements under the scheme. The facilities of these homes can also be availed by children accompanying the mothers.

State Government of Rajasthan has informed that during the last three years period from 2019-20 to 2021-22, total 1065 women and 466 children have been benefited from Swadhar Greh Scheme. These homes are functional in Jaipur, Udaipur, Kota, Baran, Dungarpur, Bundi, Bhilwara, Jhunjhunu in the State of Rajasthan.

Shakti Sadan is a demand driven Centrally Sponsored Scheme under which funds are released as per Scheme guidelines as per need and requirement of the States and UTs. The year-wise details of funds released during the last three years under the Scheme (Swadhar Greh) are as under:
