- (a) the total number of Centrally and State protected monuments in the country as of February, 2023;
- (b) the additions made to the list of Centrally protected monuments in last five years, year-wise;
- (c) the number and details of Centrally protected monuments that have become untraceable by the ASI as of February, 2023, State-wise;
- (d) the reasons as to why these monuments currently remain untraceable;
- (e) the number of Centrally protected monuments currently equipped with security personnel; and
- (f) whether Government is planning on conducting a comprehensive physical survey of all monuments, if so, expected timeline for doing so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION

- (a) There are 3696 monuments and sites declared as of national importance under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958 in the country.
- (b) Details of additions made to the list of Centrally protected monuments during the last five years are given at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) Details of 24 untraceable monuments are given at Annexure-II.
- (d) Vigorous efforts to locate/identify the reportedly untraceable monuments based on verification of old records, revenue maps and referring published reports were carried out by the respective field officers of Archaeological Survey of India.
- (e) Security at monuments is provided by watch and ward staff, regular MTS, private security personnel, State Police guards and CISF depending upon nature of site and requirement.
- (f) Inspection of monuments and sites is taken up by Archaeological Survey of India's officials/officers from time to time to assess their condition accordingly annual works programme is drawn for conservation and maintenance. This is a regular phenomenon.
