Implementation of Green India Mission in Tamil Nadu

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of implementation of the Green India Mission (GIM) in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, disbursed, and utilized, State-wise under GIM from the year 2016 to 2021;
- (c) whether the Central Government has new plans to consider the soil and weatherconditions under the National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC) while undertakingthe afforestation activities; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a)The State Forest Department of Tamil Nadu had earlier submitted a Perspective Plan to this Ministry under Green India Mission (GIM). The Ministry had communicated detailed observations on the perspective plan and had requested the State Forest Department to incorporate the same and submit the revised perspective plan.
- (b) The State-wise funds allocated/disbursed and utilized under GIM from 2015-16 to 2020-21 is detailed in Annexure-1.
- (c)&(d) National Mission for a Green India is one of the eight Mission's outlined under the National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC). It aims at protecting, restoring and enhancing India's forest cover and responding to Climate Change through afforestation activities in the selected vulnerable landscapes by considering the soil, weather and other ecological conditions.
