TARGETED NUMBER OF REGISTRATION ON E-SHRAM PORTAL

2657. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has launched e-Shram portal, a National Database of the Unorganised Workers seeded with Aadhaar, recently;**
- (b) the percentage of targeted number of registrations achieved till date along with district- wise details for Karnataka;**
- (c) the shortfall, if any, compared to the targeted number of registrations achieved, till date, State-wise along with district-wise details for Karnataka; and**
- (d) the criteria and basis on which the targeted number of registrations are decided for each State?**

(a) to (d): Ministry of Labour and Employment has launched eShram portal, a National Database of Unorganised Workers on 26th August, 2021 which is Aadhaar seeded and authenticated.

As on 16th March 2023, 39.73% of targeted number of registrations has been achieved in the State of Karnataka. District wise number of unorganised workers registered on e-Shram Portal in the State of Karnataka is at Annexure -I.

As on 16th March, 2023, State-wise shortfall in comparison to the targeted number of registrations on e-Shram is at Annexure - II. The targets have been fixed States/ UTs- wise only.

The targets for registration are based on Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) 2017-18.
