INFRASTRUCTURE AND MEDICAL FACILITIES IN ESIC

2661. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of hospitals and dispensaries run by ESIC along with the number of beneficiaries, as on date, State-wise;
- (b)whether the number of hospitals under ESI Health Scheme is very less compared to ever increasing number of beneficiaries and if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken by Government in this regard;
- (c)whether infrastructure and medical facilities are very poor in ESI run hospitals; and
- (d)if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor and the steps taken by Government to improve infrastructure and medical facilities in ESI run hospitals?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): There are 160 Employees' State Insurance (ESI) hospitals in the country, which include 51 hospitals run by the ESI Corporation (ESIC) directly and 109 hospitals run by the states under the ESI scheme (ESIS). In addition, there are 1502 ESI dispensaries in the country, which include 36 dispensaries run by the ESIC directly and 1466 dispensaries run by the states under the ESI scheme (ESIS). In addition, there are 89 Dispensary-cum-Branch Offices (DCBOs) directly run by the ESIC. As on 31.03.2022, the total number of ESI beneficiaries eligible to avail ESI benefits is 12.04 crore.

The state-wise details of the ESI hospitals, dispensaries, DCBOs and beneficiaries are placed at Annexure.

The ESI Corporation (ESIC) has also given in-principle approval for setting up of 86 new ESI hospitals to provide medical benefit to the increasing number of ESI beneficiaries. ESI hospitals provide secondary care medical services in various specialties, namely Medicine, Surgery, Gynae & Obstetrics, Orthopaedics, Paediatrics etc.

Additionally, tie-up arrangements have been made with public/ private hospitals for providing cashless in-patient medical services to ESI beneficiaries, in case, ESI hospital or in-house medical services in a particular hospital is not available.

The ESI Corporation has also collaborated with Ayushmaan Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (PMJAY) to provide secondary and tertiary care medical services to ESI beneficiaries through PMJAY empanelled hospitals in the country.

Further, ESIC has taken various steps to improve the quality of medical services in ESI Hospitals, as under:

- Enhancement of sanctioned staff strength of ESIC hospitals.
- Enhancement of 50% of bed strength, if bed occupancy is more than 70% in ESIC/ESI Scheme (ESIS) hospitals for last three consecutive years.
- Formation of state ESI societies so that States' have financial and administrative freedom to take decision for improvement of medical services.
- Allocation of additional budget under Project Implementation Plan (PIP) for State ESI Schemes.
- The Employees' State Insurance Corporation provides Rs.200/per IP per annum over and above ceiling to the state government,
 where the bed occupancy in all the State run ESIS hospitals is
 more than 70% during the previous financial year.
