### GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF TOURISM

#### RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.2695 ANSWERED ON 23.03.2023

#### **BORDER TOURISM**

#### 2695 SHRI RAKESH SINHA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plan to promote border tourism as India's borders constitute important destination of tourism;
- (b) if so, the number of spots that have been identified in this regard along with the facilities that have been provided for the purpose in terms of transport, guides, lodging and food; and
- (c) if not, whether Government would consider promoting border tourism?

#### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

#### (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

The Ministry of Tourism promotes tourism in the country, including in the border (a) to (c): areas, through its various Schemes. It provides financial assistance for development of tourism infrastructure in the country, including in the border states under its major Schemes of Swadesh Darshan and National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) to State Governments / Union Territory Administrations/ Central Agencies. The financial assistance is given on the basis of submission of Detailed Project Reports, availability of funds and adherence to Scheme Guidelines. The Swadesh Darshan scheme has now been revamped for development of sustainable and responsible tourist as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD 2.0) destinations. The details of the projects sanctioned by Ministry of Tourism, under the above Schemes, in the border states, are given in the Annexure.

Further, Ministry also promotes India in a holistic manner through various initiatives under its Schemes of "Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion & Publicity (OPP)", including in the border States. It releases print, electronic, online and outdoor media campaigns in the domestic and international markets, under the "Incredible India" brand-line, to promote various tourism destinations and products of India. The Ministry of Tourism also regularly promotes the tourism destinations through its website and social media promotions.

Some of the major initiatives and efforts of Ministry of Tourism for promotion of tourism in the border States are given below: -

- i. An amount of Rs.1312 lakh was sanctioned to Border Security Force (BSF) for the tourism related Infrastructural Development at Joint Check Post (JCP), Attari, Punjab in 2017-18.
- ii. An amount of Rs.1767.66 lakh was sanctioned to Border Security Force (BSF) for development of border tourism at BSF Check Post, Tanot complex, Rajasthan in 2022-23.
- Road connectivity and way side amenities For promotion of Border Tourism, Ministry of Tourism has taken up the matter with the Border Road Organization (BRO) for improving road connectivity and wayside amenities to the following three

(03) border areas at Pangong Lake, Ladakh, Kargil, Ladakh and Rishikesh, Uttarakhand.

Further, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, has intimated that the Government has approved Vibrant Villages Programme on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023 for 2967 villages of 46 blocks in 19 districts of Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and UT of Ladakh on northern border.

Out of these 2967 villages, 662 villages have been identified in these States / UT for coverage on priority. Promotion of tourism is one of the identified focus areas of intervention in these border villages.
