### NATIONAL TOURISM YOUTH CLUBS

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether State level National Tourism Youth Clubs (NTYCs) have been set up;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether zonal level and district level NTYC have been set up in Karnataka;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, zone-wise and district-wise;
- (e) whether NTYC activities have been undertaken in Karnataka; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, district-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (d): Ministry of Tourism, Government of India have initiated the formation of Yuva Tourism Clubs at Schools, Colleges and Universities in connection with "Azadi ka Amrit Mahosav" celebrations. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has issued detailed guidelines for the formation of Yuva Tourism clubs across the country, in CBSE affiliated schools. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan and Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti have come forward to support this initiative of Ministry of Tourism. Many colleges and Universities in the country have also already formed Yuva Tourism Clubs.

- (4) In order to showcase the rich culture & art form of Karnataka, ITO, Bengaluru hosted a cultural evening & provided IITGs (Incredible India Tourist Guides) services in all the prominent tourist destinations for the Yuva Sangam Members under EBSB program from North East India who visited Bengaluru & Mysore from 03.03.2023 to 07.03.2023.
