2791 SHRI S. KALYANASUNDARAM: SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised for paddy procurement for the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise for the year 2022-23;
- (b) the total quantity of paddy procured by Government from the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise for the year 2022-23;
- (c) whether Government has any plans to streamline the Paddy Procurement Centres through eDPC and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the amount of paddy lost due to wastage and pilferage for the year 2022-23, district-wise for the State of Tamil Nadu?

A N S W E R MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a): No State-wise and district-wise separate allocation of funds is made by Government of India for procurement and distribution of paddy. However, an amount of Rs.7063.69 crore has been released as on 21.03.2023 to State Government of Tamil Nadu for distribution of food grains for Central schemes covered under National Food Security Act and Other Welfare Schemes during the year 2022-23.
- (b): As intimated by State Government of Tamil Nadu, 26,58,235 MTs of paddy has been procured during KMS 2022-23 up to 14.03.2023. Details of district-wise paddy procurement for the KMS 2022-23 is enclosed at Annexure I.
- (c) and (d): As intimated by State Government, necessary arrangement have been made to form a centralized farmers data base (GRAINS) throughout the State with integration of various Departments' data with the help of Aadhar numbers of farmers. Further, to identify the land locations, geo-tagging is being planned in the State's online module (GRAINS). In order to streamline the paddy procurement during ensuing KMS, farmer's Aadhar authentication is going to be introduced and State is also planning to introduce Aadhar enabled Payment System (AePS).
- (e): As intimated by State Government, there was no loss due to wastage and pilferage for the year 2022-23.
