**Implementation of PMMSY in Tamil Nadu**

Will the Minister of **Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries from the State of Tamil Nadu in the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) scheme, district-wise till December 2022;
