(a) to (d) The infrastructure creation and upgradation of Railway Police Stations is an ongoing process. The work of creation/upgradation is taken up based on priority and availability of funds. The infrastructure requirement of Government Railway Police/Odisha is processed by respective Divisional Railway Manager accordingly for approval and execution. Whenever, any proposal for new infrastructure is received from Government Railway Police Authority, the same is considered based on availability of funds.
