Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the farmers have obstructed the work on the Baddi-Chandigarh rail line due to non-payment of compensation for the land acquired for the railway line;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total land acquired in the State of Himachal Pradesh under the said railway line project and the States where the land has been acquired for this railway line?

- (a) and (b): Yes, Sir. Farmers have intermittently obstructed the work on the Chandigarh-Baddi (33 km) new rail line project in the State of Himachal Pradesh. The project is a cost sharing project wherein Government of Himachal Pradesh is sharing 50% of project cost.
- (c) Land acquisition between Baddi to Chandigarh has been taken up as detailed below:
 - Himachal Pradesh: 34.66 Ha land involved in 9 villages out of which 30.32 Ha Land (Private- 28.72 Ha, Govt.- 1.6 Ha) has been acquired and balance 4.346 Ha (Private-4.096 Ha and Govt.- 0.25 Ha) in different stages of acquisition
 - Haryana (60.21 Ha involved in 21 villages): Complete 60.21 Ha (Private- 44.33 Ha, Govt.- 15.66 Ha and forest- 0.22 Ha) has been acquired.
