(a): The implementation of Digi Yatra under phase I is planned at Kolkata, Pune, Vijayawada and Hyderabad Airports besides Delhi, Bangalore and Varanasi airports where it has already been implemented. It is to be implemented across various other airports in the country in a phased manner.

(b): Digi Yatra has been successfully launched at Delhi, Bangalore and Varanasi Airports and has proved to be time saving, convenient and hassle free for the passengers. Furthermore, it enhances security standards at the airports. The system in place is stable.
