COMPULSORY NCC TRAINING IN SCHOOLS/COLLEGES

2929 SHRI P. WILSON:

Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is considering to make National Cadet Corps (NCC) training compulsory in Schools/Colleges across the country including in the State of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the number of schools/colleges voluntarily providing NCC training, district-wise, school-wise, college-wise; in Tamil Nadu;
- (c) whether NCC is equipped to impart training in Indian Army, Navy and Air Force too, if so, the details of availability of such facilities; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): No such proposal is under consideration.
- (b): 921 schools and 534 colleges are providing NCC training in 38 districts of Tamil Nadu.
- (c) & (d): The three wings of NCC, viz, Army, Navy and Air Force impart wing-specific training to the cadets as per the NCC curriculum. For imparting training, Permanent Instructors (PIs) staff are posted from the concerned Service Headquarters. In addition, Associate NCC Officers (ANOs) from the schools and colleges are imparted training for giving further training to the cadets.
