SLUM DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS UNDER SMART CITIES MISSION (SCM) IN ANDHRA PRADESH

NO. 2937. SHRI G.V.L. NARASIMHA RAO:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the guidelines for undertaking slum development projects under Smart Cities Mission;
- (b) the smart cities that have undertaken slum development projects worth over ₹ 100 crore and nature of projects undertaken by them;
- (c) the smart cities selected in Andhra Pradesh and the complete list of projects undertaken under Smart Cities Mission;
- (d) the details of slum development projects undertaken by smart cities in Andhra Pradesh;
- (e) the slum clusters and slum population of Visakhapatnam and the details of slum development projects undertaken in Visakhapatnam, if any;
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (g) the funds provided to Visakhapatnam for slum development under other programmes?

ANSWER

(a) to (g): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. SCM has a two-fold strategy comprising Area Based Development (ABD) and Pan City Development. The typologies of Area-based development under SCM are city improvement (retrofitting), city renewal (redevelopment) and city extension (Greenfield development). Affordable housing, including slum redevelopment has been undertaken as one of the infrastructure elements under the overall work of ABD under SCM.

In the State of Andhra Pradesh, 4 cities i.e. Amaravati, Kakinada, Tirupati & Visakhapatnam were selected for development as Smart Cities. The details of projects being developed under SCM by the Smart Cities in Andhra Pradesh are given below:-

The Smart Cities of Bhopal, Indore, Agra, Bilaspur and Ahmedabad have undertaken slum redevelopment projects worth over ₹ 100 crore which, inter alia, include construction of houses and development of infrastructure for identified slum localities, redevelopment of slums with integrated urban plaza, mixed-use development, Public-Private Partnership based slum rehabilitation etc. There are no Smart City projects related to slum redevelopment being implemented by Visakhapatnam Smart City. The works of slum redevelopment undertaken in Smart Cities, including Andhra Pradesh, as on 3 March 2023, is given in Annexure-I.

Moreover, 'Land' and 'Colonization' are State subjects. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), under the vision of 'Housing for All', supplements the efforts of States/Union Territories (UTs) by providing Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana- Urban (PMAY-U) for construction of houses for eligible families/beneficiaries. Eligible beneficiaries avail the benefit of PMAY-U through four verticals, i.e., Beneficiary-led Construction or enhancement (BLC); Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP); 'In-Situ' Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS). The ISSR component of the scheme is specifically for redevelopment of slums. Out of the 1.20 crore houses sanctioned under PMAY-U, 109.39 lakh houses have been grounded for construction, of which 72.72 lakh houses have been completed/delivered to beneficiaries. The Scheme has been extended, except CLSS vertical, upto 31.12.2024 to complete houses sanctioned till 31.03.2022. The State of Andhra Pradesh has not proposed any project under ISSR vertical of the Scheme.
