NATIONAL URBAN LIVELIHOOD MISSION

NO. 2938: SHRI DHANANJAY BHIMRAO MAHADIK:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) whether Government is implementing National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) and if so, the details thereof along with achievement made since inception;
- b) the details of funds sanctioned under National Urban Livelihoods Mission during the last three years for Maharashtra;
- c) the number of Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) constructed in Maharashtra along with the details of their capacity; and
- d) the details of funds spent on construction of shelters and maintenance of the same?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a): Yes, Sir. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. The mission also aims at building strong grass root level institutions of the urban poor, providing shelters equipped with essential services to the urban homeless persons and addressing livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces, institutional credit, social security, etc.

A statement showing State/Union Territory (UT)-wise physical progress of the DAY-NULM under various components as on 28.2.2023 is at Annexure-I.

- (b): During the last three years (i.e. FY 2019-20 to FY 2021-22), ₹160.52 crore has been released as Central Assistance to the State of Maharashtra under DAY-NULM.
- (c)&(d): Under DAY-NULM, Central Assistance is released to States/ UTs including Maharashtra as a whole. The *inter-se* allocation of funds under different components including SUH of the Mission is done by the respective States/ UTs, as per their requirements. Under SUH, funds are utilised on construction, refurbishment and operations and management (O&M) of shelters. As per information given by State Government of Maharashtra, ₹70.4 crore has been spent on construction, refurbishment and O&M of shelters. As on 28.2.2023, 96 shelters having capacity of 4,961, have been made functional in the State of Maharashtra.
