PROGRESS OF AMRUT 2.0 IN THE STATE OF WEST BENGAL

NO. 2942. SHRI MOHAMMED NADIMUL HAQUE:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of households in 500 cities covered in first phase of AMRUT 2.0 that have been provided with sewage/septage management till now, State-wise;
- (b) the number of projects finalized, undertaken, and number of projects completed in West Bengal under AMRUT 1.0 and AMRUT 2.0, respectively;
- (c) the amount of central assistance approved, and amount released for the State of West Bengal; and
- (d) the details of any other projects that have been undertaken under AMRUT in West Bengal and the progress thereof?

(a): State-wise details of Sewerage Connections provided/serviced & Households covered under Septage management through Atal Mission for Rejuvenation & Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and in convergence with other schemes is placed at ANNEXURE.

(b): In the State of West Bengal, 60 cities have been selected under AMRUT Mission. Against the approved plan size of ₹4,035 crore, the State of West Bengal has grounded 473 projects worth ₹4,032.44 crore. of which, 432 projects worth ₹2,151.65 crore have been completed. Total works worth ₹3,564.07 crore have been physically completed and ₹3,083.84 crore expended so far.

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Under AMRUT 2.0, 134 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) / Cities are covered in the State of West Bengal. So far, 300 projects worth ₹8,167.57 crore (capital expenditure cost) have been approved by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). Of this, contracts have been awarded for 22 projects worth ₹137.12 crore and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been prepared for another 98 projects worth ₹3,500.62 crore.

(c): Under AMRUT Mission, in the State of West Bengal total State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) worth ₹4,035 crore have been approved, which includes committed central assistance of ₹1,929.32 crore. So far, ₹1,905.39 crore has been released for implementation of projects against which Utilization Certificates (UCs) worth ₹1,511.20 crore has been received. Overall, ₹2,162.83 crore central assistance has been released for various components against which UCs of ₹1,754.13 crore have been received.

Under AMRUT 2.0, central assistance allocated for the State of West Bengal is ₹3,658 crore for projects & ₹118.88 crore for Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE). So far, projects worth ₹8,167.57 crore (capital expenditure cost) including central assistance of ₹2,930.14 have been approved by MoHUA. Central Assistance of ₹495.65 crore has been released for projects and ₹18.80 crore released for A&OE purposes.

(d): Under AMRUT, State of West Bengal has grounded 46 projects worth ₹3,443.15 crore in water supply sector including 28 completed projects worth ₹1956.84 crore. So far, 16.23 Lakh household water tap connections have been provided through these projects and in convergence with other schemes & 330 Million Liters Per Day (MLD) water treatment capacity has been created. In sewerage & septage sector, 3 projects have been grounded worth ₹192.5 crore including one completed project worth ₹15 crore. In storm water drainage, 7 projects worth ₹301.50 crore have been grounded of which 2 projects worth ₹89.99 crore have been completed. 45.50 Km of drains has been constructed. Under non-motorized urban transport, 2 projects worth ₹5 crore have been taken up and completed. Under Green space and parks, 415 projects worth ₹90.29 crore have been grounded, of which, 399 projects worth ₹84.82 crore have been completed leading to development of 235-acre green area & public spaces.
