STATUS OF SMART CITIES MISSION IN MAHARASHTRA

NO. 2953. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the cities selected under Smart Cities Mission (SCM) in the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) whether the goals/targets set under Smart Cities Mission in Maharashtra is yet to be achieved and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the quantum of funds allocated to Maharashtra under the SCM is very less and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether Government has set any target to complete SCM in the year 2023 and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (d): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. 8 cities in the State of Maharashtra namely Aurangabad, Kalyan-Dombivali, Nagpur, Nashik, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Pune, Solapur and Thane have been selected for development as Smart Cities. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years to the 100 Smart Cities i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year.

As on 3 March 2023, 74% of the total projects in Smart Cities of Maharashtra have been completed and 66% of allocated funds over the Mission period have been utilized by its Smart Cities. The progress of implementation of SCM and details of funds released/utilized under SCM Maharashtra is given in Annexure-I.

The period of implementation of SCM has been extended upto June 2023 and all Smart Cities, including those in Maharashtra, are expected to complete their projects within the stipulated time.
