**FORMAL AND INFORMAL EMPLOYMENT UNDER MSMEs IN TELANGANA**

2994. DR. K. LAXMAN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of formal and informal employment in MSMEs during the last five years in the State of Telangana, district-wise;
- (b) whether Government has taken any steps to boost employment and improve employment conditions in MSME; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a): As per Udyam Registration Portal, following its inception on 01.07.2020 to 22.03.2023, the total number of persons employed in the MSMEs which are registered on the Udyam Registration portal in the State of Telangana was 62,89,528. The district wise details are attached as annexure-I.

Under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), the estimated number of employment generated in the State of Telangana during 2017-18 to 2021-22 was 82,768. The district wise details are attached as annexure II.

(b) to (c): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises implements various schemes for the growth and development of MSME sector to boost employment in the country. The schemes/programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry & Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP) and National SC/ST Hub (NSSH).

The Government has taken a number of recent initiatives to support MSMEs in the country, which inter alia include:

- (i) Rs. 5 lakh crore Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) for business, including MSMEs.
- (ii) Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Self-Reliant India Fund.
- (iii) New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
- (iv) No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores.
- (v) "Udyam Registration" for MSMEs, for Ease of Doing Business.
- (vi) Launching of an online Portal "Champions" in June, 2020 to cover many aspects of e-governance including grievance redress and handholding of MSMEs.
- (vii) Inclusion of Retail and Wholesale trades as MSMEs w.e.f. 02nd July, 2021.
- (viii) Non-tax benefits extended for 3 years in case of an upward change in status of MSMEs.
- (ix) Roll out of Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) programme with an outlay of Rs. 6,000 crore over 5 years.
- (x) Launch of Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) on 11.01.2023 to bring the Informal Micro Enterprises (IMEs) under the formal ambit for availing the benefit under Priority Sector Lending (PSL).
