- (b) whether Government is considering on restarting these petrol pumps; and
- (c) if so, whether any time limit has been set therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have informed that as on 01.01.2023, there are 130 numbers of closed/nil selling ROs of Public Sector OMCs in Madhya Pradesh. District-wise number of such ROs is given in **Annexure.**

Public Sector OMCs have further informed that action for restarting of these closed/nil selling ROs is taken as per the extant guidelines on case to case basis.
