ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) under the Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR) has informed that phase-I of its Phytopharmaceutical Mission (2017-2020) focused on the captive cultivation of important medicinal plants of therapeutic value and pre-clinical development of leads based on eight medicinal plants has developed the capabilities and expertise to work on the phytopharmaceutical route of drug development. The first phase has resulted in one IND filing to the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO), for the plant Bergenia ciliata (IIIM-160), a dual inhibitor of IL-6 and nociception for the management of pain in rheumatoid arthritis. Phase-II of the Mission (2021-2023) is focused on the pre-clinical development of six leads, which are ready for IND filing with the CDSCO.

CSIR has further informed that it is working under a tripartite agreement with the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) towards the preclinical development of phytopharmaceutical leads, Cannavis sativa and Boswellia serrata, for pain management and rheumatoid arthritis treatment, respectively. Both of these leads are currently under IND-enabling studies.
