- (d) the reasons for delay in the launch of the system and estimated timeline for the same?

(a) to (d): A consulting agency was engaged to develop a conceptual framework for Early Warning system (EWS) and conduct two proof of concepts before drafting a request for proposal (RFP) for selection of 'Managed Service Provider'. The consulting agency had carried out the proof of concept during 2017-18. Later on, RFP was floated. However, on account of mismatch in the financial bids received and the estimates, the project was not pursued further.
